The report is available for download.

To show the progress the EU has made to reach its sustainability goals, the monitoring report uses a set of Europe-wide sustainability indicators. These indicators cover several issues ranging from climate change to economic growth as well as public health to biodiversity.

The Eurostat monitoring report has been published every two years. Ecologic Institute contributed to the report for the forth time. In this year's report <u>Katharina Umpfenbach</u>, worked on Climate & Energy, <u>Andreas Graf</u> on Natural Ressources and <u>Christiane Gerstetter</u> and <u>Doris Knoblauch</u> on Global Partnership.
