Markus Knigge is Executive Director of the <u>Blue Action Fund</u> and has overall responsibility for implementing and evaluating its grant programme, as well as for managing day-to-day operations.

Prior to Blue Action Fund, Markus worked in various positions for the <u>Pew Charitable Trusts</u> where he built up the European Marine Program and led Pew's efforts to end overfishing in the EU. He also worked as EU Marine Programme Officer with the <u>WWF European Policy Office</u> and as a senior fellow with the Ecologic Institute in Berlin and Brussels.

As a scholar of the German Academic Exchange Service, Markus graduated with distinction from the School of Advanced International Studies at Johns Hopkins University with a master's degree in international affairs and international economics. Prior to that, he received the equivalent of a masterâ of degree in urban and regional planning from Technische Universit Axt Berlin (Germany). In 2004, Markus was awarded the John J. McCloy Fellowship in Environmental Affairs.
