On 8 July 2013, Ecologic Institute began the 2013 Arctic Summer College. Ecologic Institute's Arctic Program hosts the program alongside a number of institutional partners: the Center for Strategic and International Studies (CSIS); the Embassy of Canada, Germany; the International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN); and the WWF Global Arctic Programme.

The Arctic Summer College brings together emerging leaders to build a lasting, policy-oriented network of Arctic professionals to strengthen communication between peoples and nations, scientific disciplines, policy areas, and across the science-policy interface to improve environmental governance in the Arctic region.

Weekly seminars held from 8 July until 26 August 2013 will focus on scientific research, biodiversity, the IMO Polar Code, ecosystem-based management, life in the North and environmental changes and challenges, business engagement and sustainability, the geopolitical consequences of a changing Arctic, and the Arctic Council.
