Dr. Josselin Rouillard is an Associate of Ecologic Institute. He joined Ecologic Institute Berlin as a Fellow in 2013 and works on environmental governance and economics, with specific expertise in water and river basin management, climate change adaptation and rural development. He has a strong background in both academic research and consultancy services for supporting the implementation of European water, climate and rural development policies. Josselin Rouillard is a native French speaker, is fluent in English and has a good knowledge of Spanish.

At Ecologic Institute, Josselin Rouillard was involved in supporting the European Commission on strengthening the implementation of the Water Framework Directive, with regards to [the coherence of water and rural development policies](#) [1] and [hydromorphological pressures and the definition of good ecological potential](#) [2]. He was a member of the [European Topic Centre on Inland Coastal and Marine waters](#) [3] (ETC-ICM) and supported the European Environment Agency in its assessment of the state of European waters. Josselin also supported [the development of economic instruments to support river basin management in South America](#) [4] and [the implementation of ecosystem based management for the protection of European freshwater, coastal and marine waters](#) [5].

Before joining Ecologic Institute Josselin Rouillard was a research associate for the [School of Geosciences at the University of Edinburgh](#) [6] and for the [IHP-HELP Centre for Water Law, Policy and Science](#) [7] at the University of Dundee, where he worked on a variety of research projects on energy governance, river basin management and the ecosystem services approach. He also worked for the [Centre for Ecology and Hydrology](#) [8] as an environmental consultant (free-lance associated with Europe-Planet Earth and for [ACTeon](#) [9]) and as an intern for the [European Environmental Bureau](#) [10] in Brussels.

Josselin Rouillard completed his doctorate studies in 2012 as part of a collaborative program between the [Scottish Alliance for Geoscience, Environment and Society](#) [11], the University of Dundee and the University of

Edinburgh. His thesis was on adaptive water governance, flood risk management and rural development in Scotland. He holds a MSc in Environmental Change and Management from the University of Oxford and a BSc in Environmental Sciences from the University of Reading.
