**Introduction**  
 Ecologic Institute and the Atlantic Council of the United States co-organize the ELEEP Leaders in Environmental and Trade Policy Network (ELEEP). ELEEP was created under the same project, which was funded for the European Union's 5th and 6th Action Plans. In early 2012, the ELEEP Network was awarded additional support for the Brussels Study Tour, which provided for two study tours and other events in the second half of the year. The ELEEP Network has received additional funding from the European Union under the auspices of the EU Transatlantic Dialogue Dialogue (EU-USA 2012), with the grant. Ecologic Institute and the Atlantic Council will continue the ELEEP Energy and Climate Dialogue from January 2012 through mid-2014. In addition to a second round of funding from the European Union, the Robert Bosch Stiftung has provided a substantial amount of support for ELEEP through mid-2014. ELEEP is a dynamic, transatlantic early forum for the exchange of ideas, policy solutions, best practices, and professional development for emerging American and European leaders working on or around environmental and energy issues. ELEEP currently has approximately 120 members, split between the US and the EU. ELEEP members provide policy advice based on their experiences and lessons from dialogue study tours addressing environmental, climate and energy issues. ELEEP members gathered in Brussels on 14 May 2014. The study tour lasted from 14 to 17 May 2014.
