"Sustainable Development within the context of economic globalisation" was the subject discussed at a seminar organised by the University Nürtingen. The event took place 26-27 November 2004 and was dedicated to raising awareness about environmental issues within Germany's higher education system. Markus Knigge, Ecologic Fellow, gave a presentation on the relationship between multilateral environmental agreements and the international trade regime.

Given the broad scope of issues within the Doha negotiations of the World Trade Organisation and the increasing number of multilateral environmental agreements which incorporate trade measures, there seems to be increasing potential for conflict between both international regimes. Within his presentation on the relationship between the international environmental regime and the WTO Markus Knigge touched upon the potential for conflict as well as co-operation and interaction.
