8th POLIMP Webinar: Are EU Climate Policies up to the Challenge of Decarbonizing Europe?

We are excited to announce the eighth and final webinar in our POLIMP Webinar Series, which will feature a discussion on the topic "Are EU climate policies up to the challenge of decarbonizing Europe?" moderated by Ecologic Institute's Benjamin Görlach (Head, Economics and Policy Assessment).

The webinar will take place on **Wednesday, 6 April 2016** from **11:00-12:00 CET** and will feature guest speaker [Prof. Michael Grubb \[2\]](#), Professor of International Energy and Climate Change Policy at UCL Institute for Sustainable Resources and Chair of Climate Strategies.

Michael Grubb is author of eight books, fifty journal research articles and numerous other publications. He has held many advisory positions with governments, companies and international studies on climate change and energy policy, and has been a Lead Author for several reports of the IPCC on mitigation. His book *Planetary Economics*, which brings together the lessons from 25 years of research and implementation of energy and climate policies, was published in March 2014: it has received widespread accolade as a 'seminal' contribution, 'comprehensive and

profoundly important' for its presentation of a new approach to both the theoretical underpinnings and the practical policies for tackling energy and climate change challenges.

The webinar will feature a discussion about how the European climate policy instrument mix should evolve until 2050 to guide the decarbonization of the European economy in line with the Paris Agreement.
