Key aspects of her work included the system and market integration of renewable energies and energy production from biomass. Anke Rostankowski is the author of a number of commentaries and articles on energy law and climate change law.

During her time as a legal trainee, Anke was involved in projects concerning national and European energy policy and advised the Ministry of Agriculture, Environment and Regional Development of the German Federal State of Brandenburg.

Anke Rostankowski studied law at the European University Viadrina in Frankfurt an der Oder (Germany), specializing in European law and international public law. In addition, she completed complementary studies in administrative sciences at the German University of Administrative Sciences in Speyer.
