Mathilde Mansoz has extensive international work experience. Together with urban planners and environmental managers, she carried out a project for the sustainable development of a Shanghai quarter, which was presented by the [Swedish ministry for environment](#) [2] at the Expo 2010 in Shanghai .

She has managed operations in films distribution in France and in the United Kingdom, and led the Operations department at Lionsgate UK in London for several years. In the past, she worked as a journalist in Japan and developed a strong attachment to Japanese culture and traditions.

Mathilde Mansoz has a degree in International Economics from La Sorbonne University in Paris and in Environmental Management and Policy from the International Institute for Industrial and Environmental Economics (IIIEE) in Lund University in Sweden. She also holds a degree in Journalism.
