Carolin Wolf started her career in the conference department of the F.A.Z. (Frankfurter Allgemeine Zeitung) Institute for Management, Market and Media Information in Frankfurt/Main. Her responsibilities included the conceptualization, preparation, and execution of events covering mainly legal themes for executives and managers. She also gained professional experience as Events Coordinator at the Berlin [Social Science Center](#) [2] (WZB).

From October 2010 until November 2012, Carolin Wolf participated in the part-time Master Study Programme [Sustainability and Quality Management](#) [3] at the Berlin School of Economics and Law. Her master's thesis analyzed the sustainability strategies of the German Federal Government and the German Federal States with a focus on whether the success of their implementation is measured on a regular basis and, if so, if and how these measurements form a basis for the political decision process.
