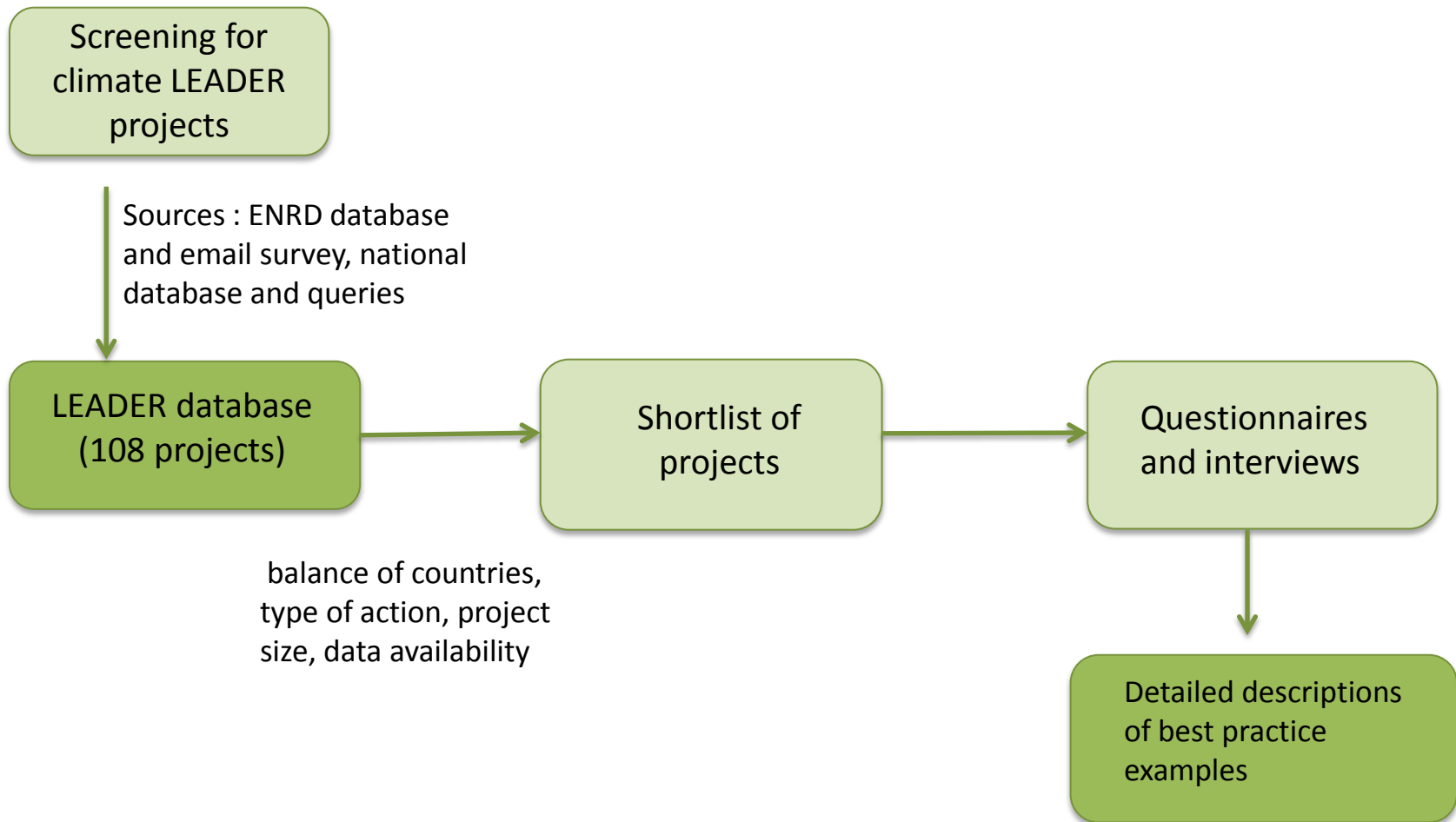

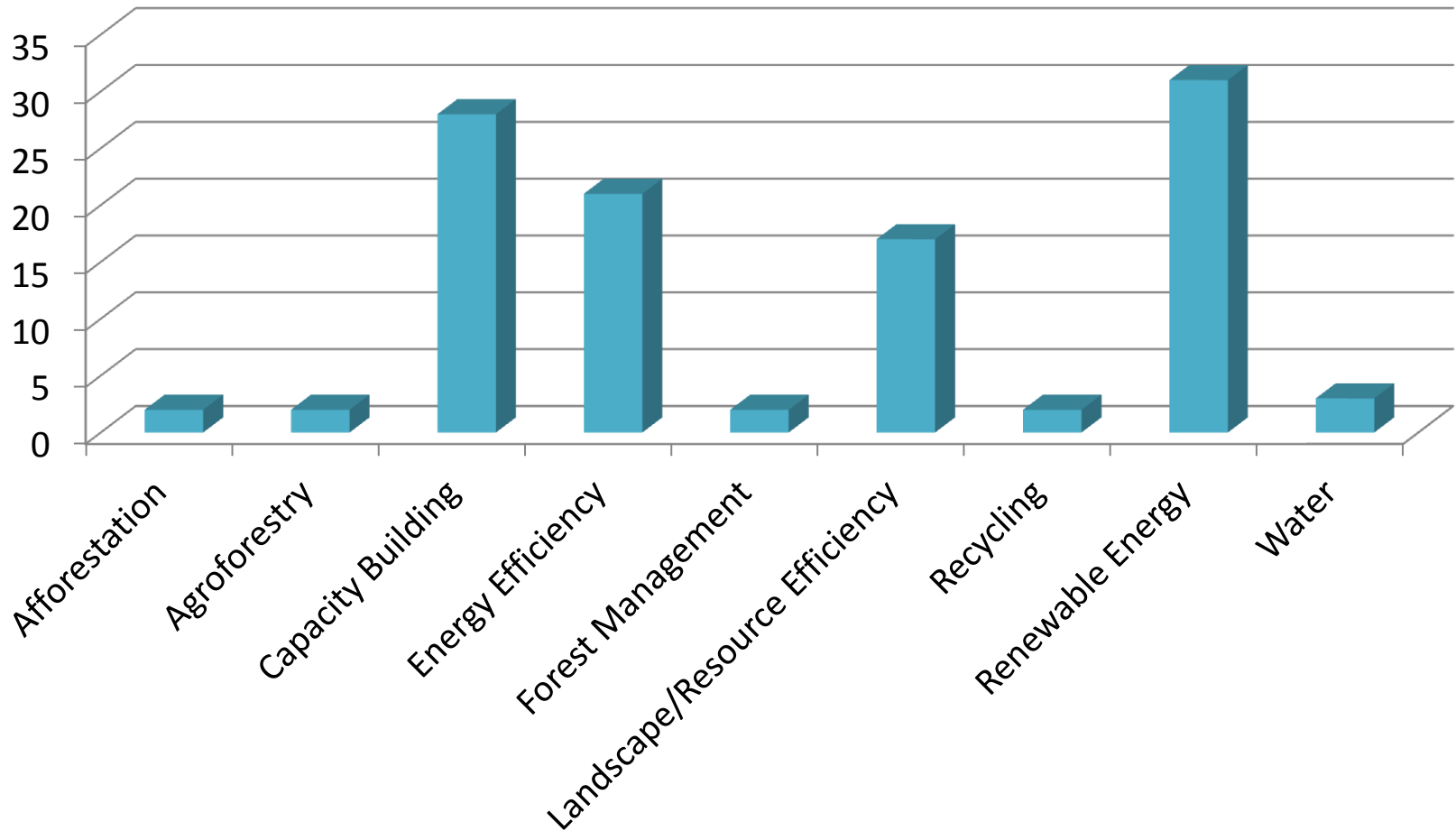
LEADER and Joint Actions – Opportunities

- ▶ Mutual learning and capacity building

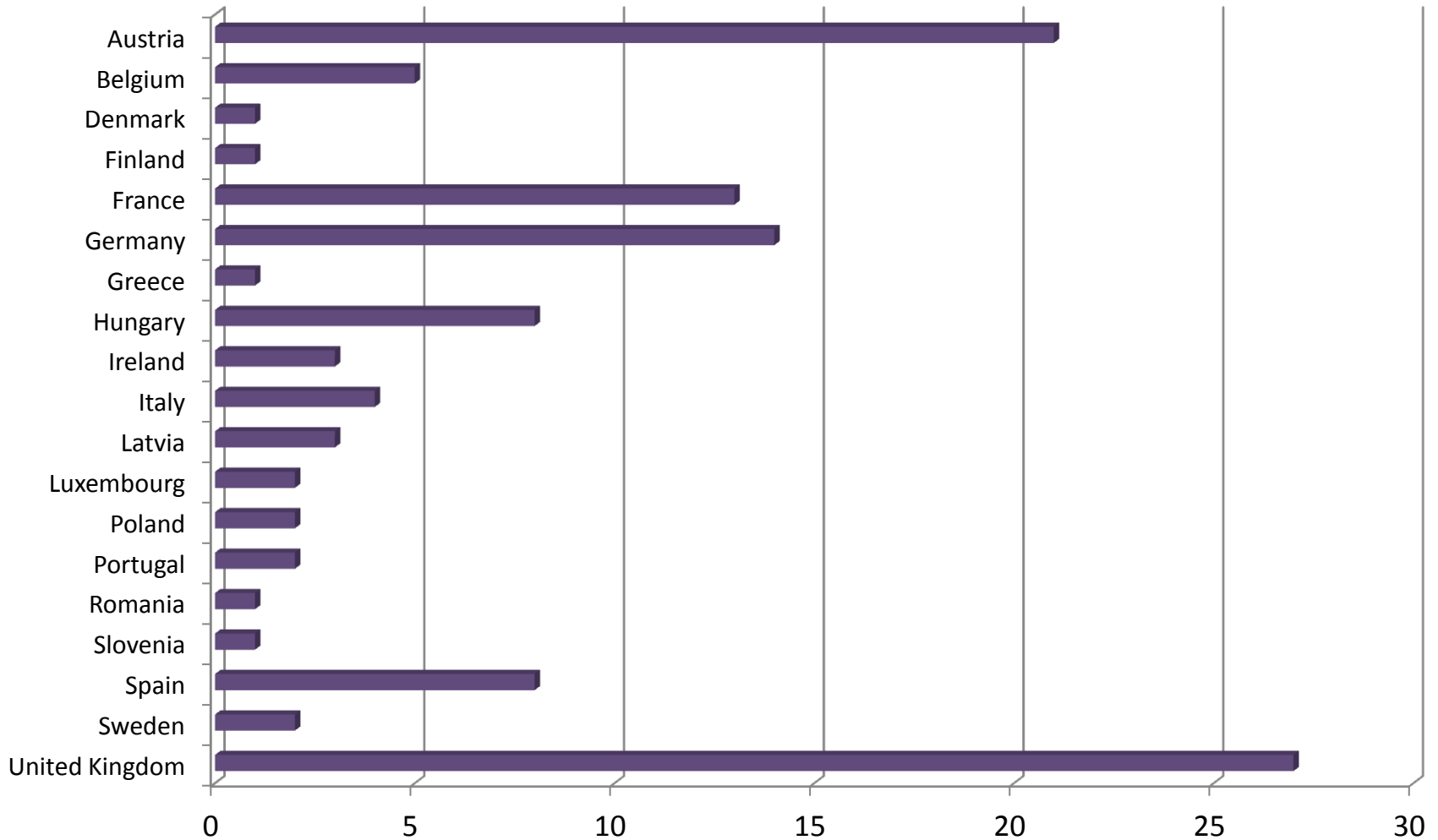
Identifying LEADER projects

- Describe project objectives and drivers, as well as actors and funding sources
- Identify multiple benefits of climate-focused projects
- Illustrate success factors and barriers
- Demonstrate how LEADER projects can act as initiators for future climate activities in the region → multiplier effects

- ▶ Identify topics suitable for Joint Action projects
- ▶ Illustrate some examples in more detail:
 - ▶ Rationale and objectives for the joint action
 - ▶ Potential actors
 - ▶ Types of activities that can be supported
 - ▶ Expected impact on mitigation and/or adaptation
 - ▶ Combinations with other RDP measures
