Emissions Trading in China and Europe: Taking Stock, Thinking Ahead, Looking Beyond

Shenzhen, 13 December 2017

Goal: China Emissions Exchange and the European Commission are delighted to host this conference on Emission Trading in China and the EU, bringing together experts from the World's current largest and the soon-to-be largest ETS. The one-day conference will

- Give updates on the latest developments in Emission Trading in China and the EU, with the imminent launch of China's national ETS and a fundamental overhaul of the EU ETS just agreed,
- Provide a forum to exchange experiences and discuss challenges with ETS design and implementation,
- Highlight the existing cooperation between China and Europe on carbon pricing, and discuss ideas for future cooperation,
- Reunite many of the ~100 Chinese alumni that have participated in the ICAP training courses since 2009.

Topics: The conference will cover the following blocks, followed by a panel discussion on the outlook for Emission Trading in China, the EU and beyond.

- C. Working Together: International Cooperation on ETS Implementation
- D. Thinking Ahead: The Role of ETS in the Transition to a Low-Carbon Economy

The conference will be held in Chinese and English, with simultaneous translation provided.
