














Introduction

- It fulfils a wide range of functions and plays a major role in improving living standards, environmental justice and climate resilience in cities.








Ways to achieve green cities – areas of action

The federal government will support the municipalities and other actors in the ten areas of action through concrete measures and recommendations for action for securing and establishing green and recreational spaces.









Integrated planning for urban green space

- ...








Upgrading green spaces and making them multifunctional

- ...








3. Using urban green spaces to enhance climate action & mitigate impacts of climate change






4. Making urban green spaces socially compatible and good for our health

- ...









5. Greenery of structures

- ...









6. Correct planning, development and maintenance of green spaces

- ...








7. Gain stakeholders and involve society

- ...








8. Intensify and interlink research






9. Expand federal government's role model function


