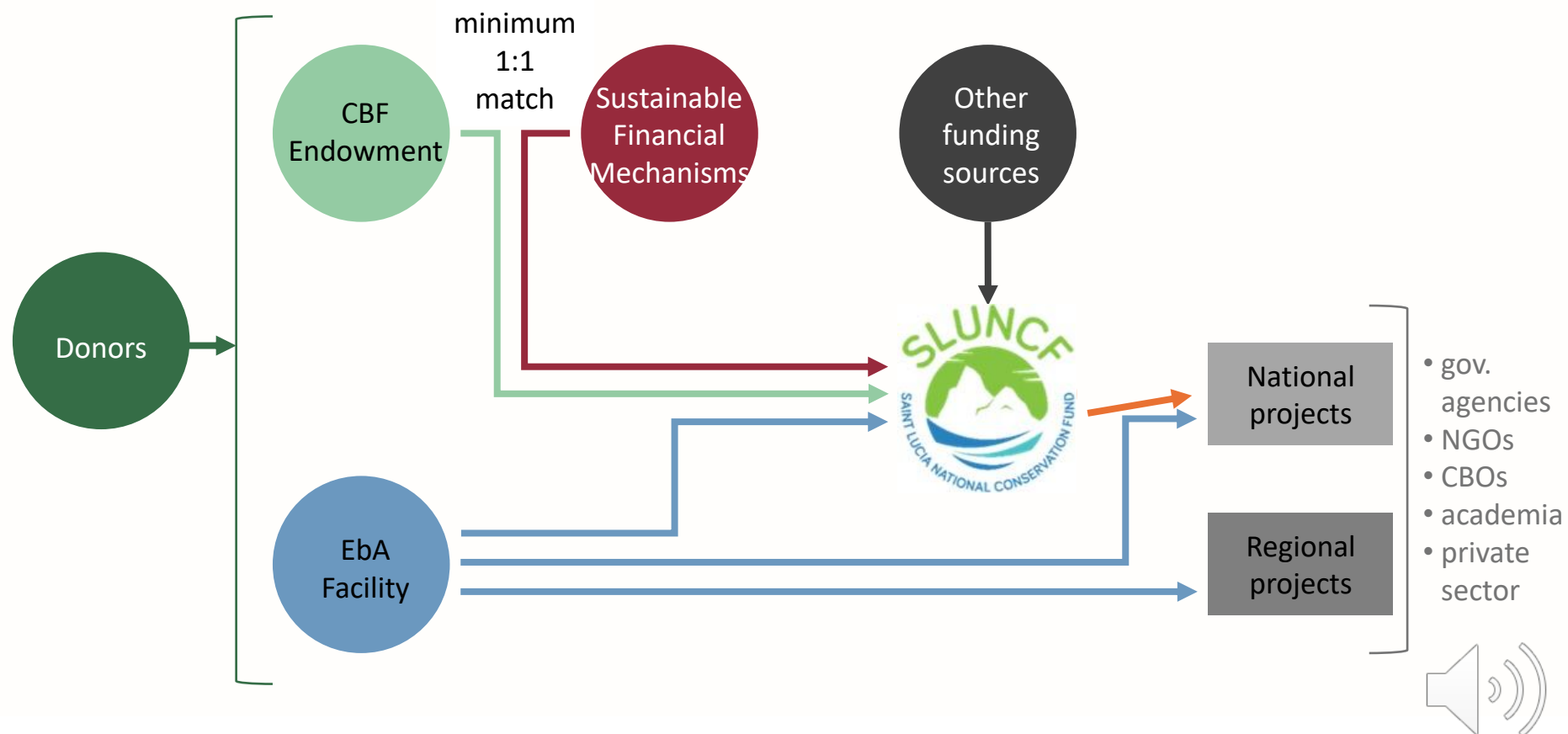

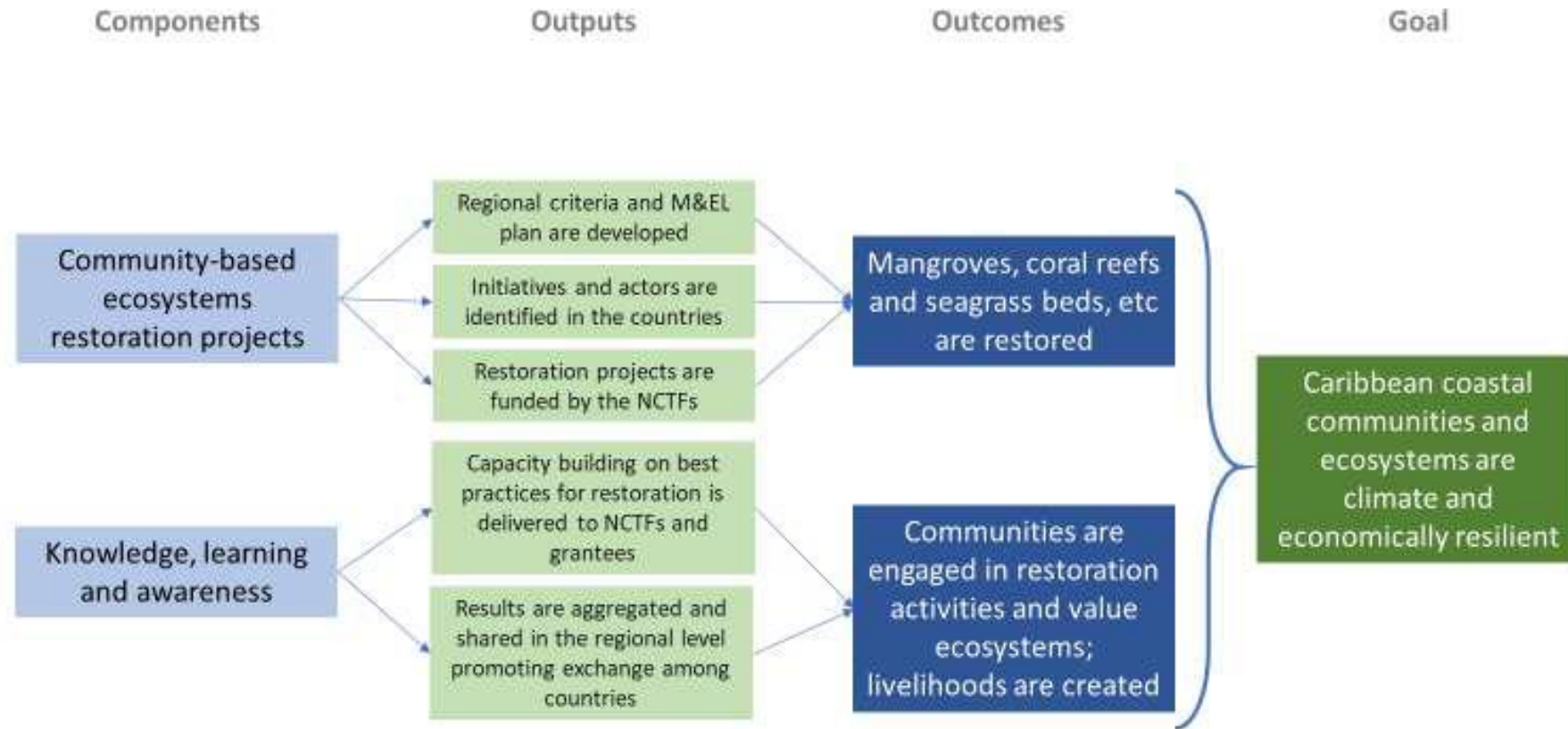

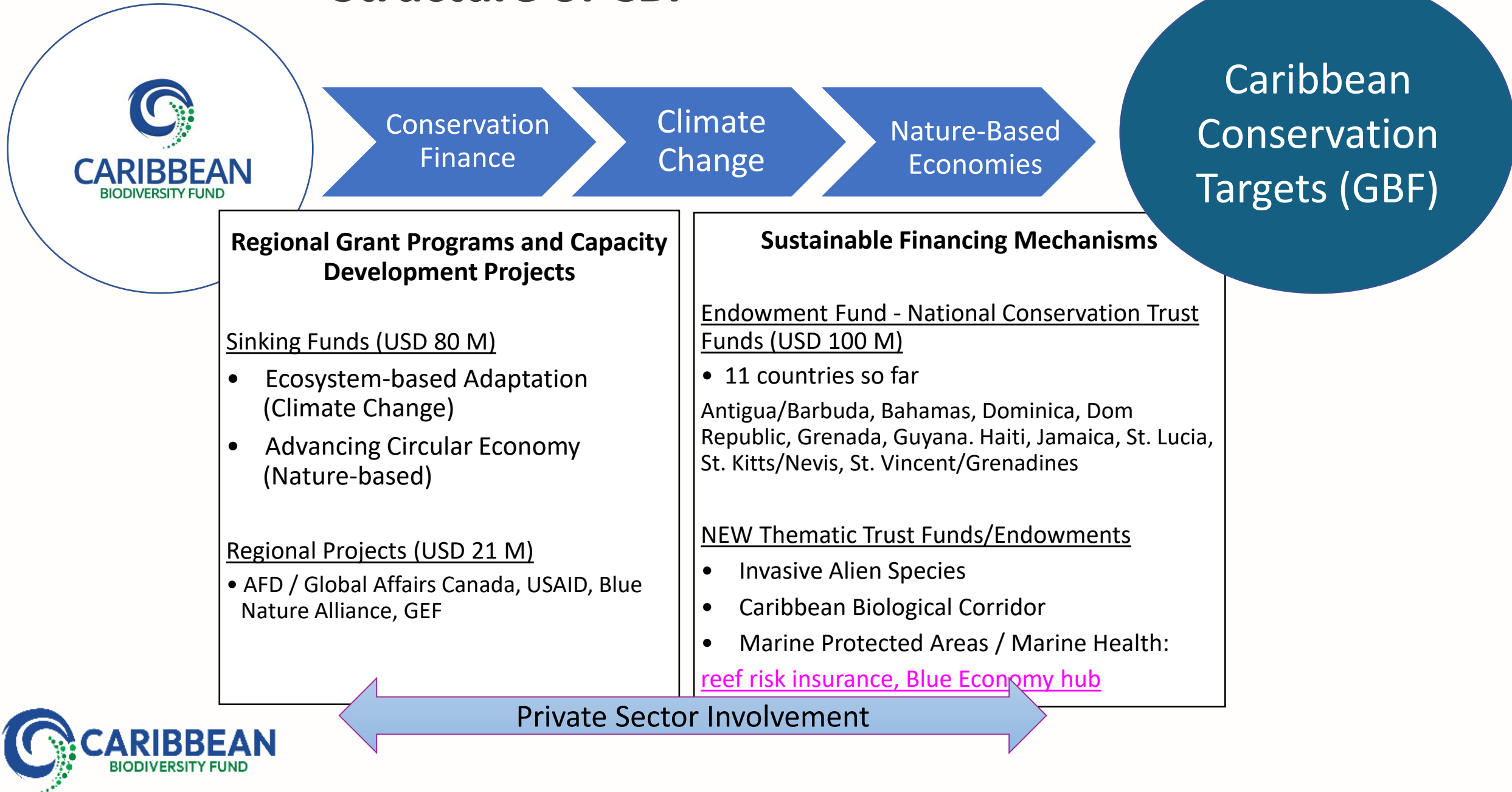


Nature based economic model – Blue Economy

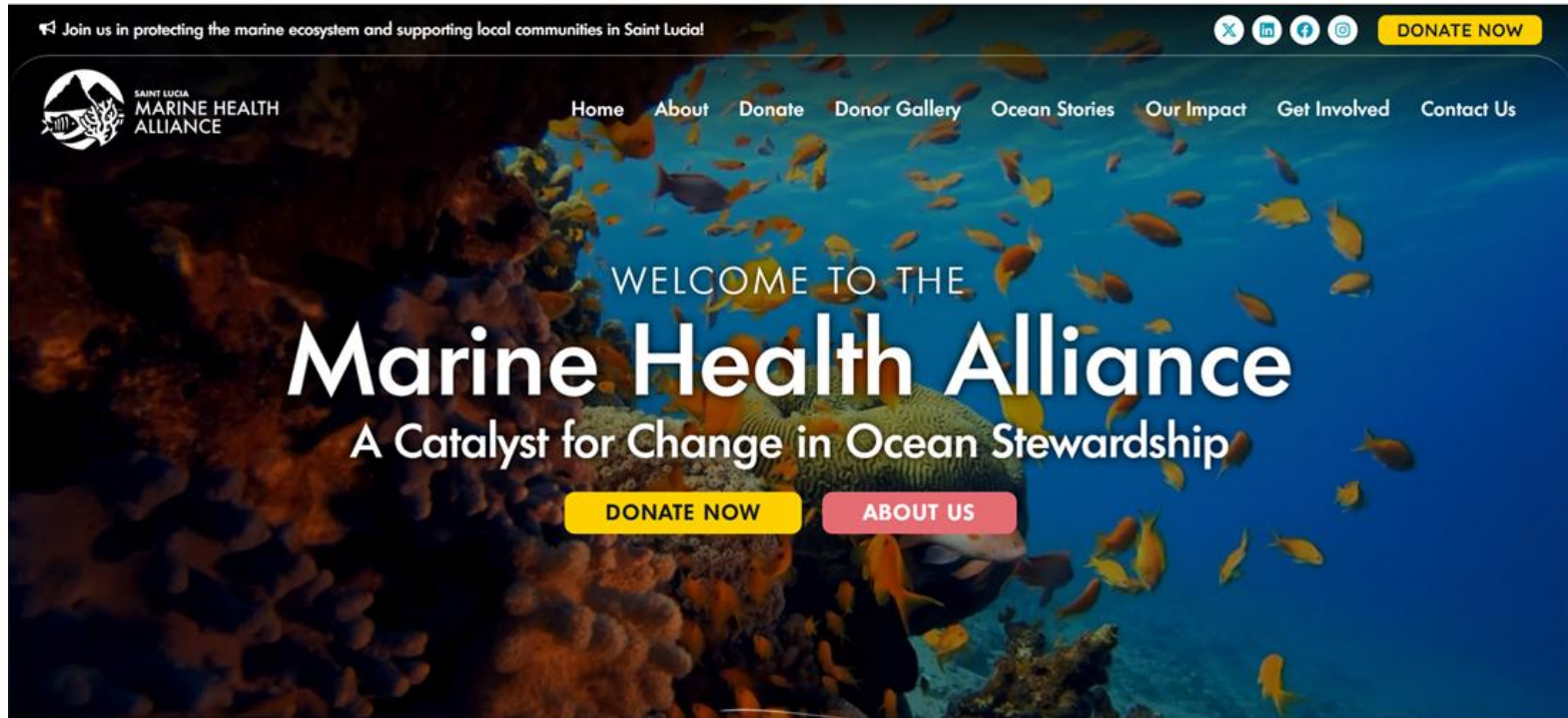
Caribbean Blue Economy: Building Coastal and Marine ecosystems resilience

REEF Partnership Strengths and Responsibilities

- **CBF:** Implementation lead responsible for overall project coordination, insurance policyholder with support from WTW, regional reef response capacity building and pay-out distribution in cooperation with partner NCTFs and with expert support from MAR Fund, long-term sustainability (and scaling) of reef insurance in the Caribbean region
- **National Conservation Trust Funds:** Partners on national-level reef response preparedness and pay-out distribution
