Where are we at? What do we know?

Urban NBS governance...

- Complex management and decision-making processes
- Rampant trade-offs, multiple stakeholders and interests
- Need for cross-sectoral collaboration and policy mixes

Diverse policy instruments available, with varying opportunities for public participation and power sharing





No ,one sized fits all' approach to NBS governance... BUT the involvement of different stakeholders is vital!

Governments & their agencies






Citizens, civil society groups, businesses (Political) champions

Key challenges and gaps

- Land use competition and related conflicts of interest/power imbalance
- Lacking approaches to consider trade-offs, including justice aspects
- Inadequate public governance structures and policy frameworks; path dependency



Where to go from here?

Accelerating action through governance innovation

Inclusive

Empower local stakeholders to participate in decisionmaking processes and formalize citizen roles
Include vulnerable and disadvantaged communities

- Ongoing learning, reflection and adaptation
- · Foster transformational societal and institutional change

Reflexive

Polycentric

- Involve governing bodies at multiple institutional scales
- Foster informal networks and collaboration between departments and sectors
