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
Creating enabling conditions: Unpacking NBS policy frameworks

- Ambition to mainstream NBS into urban planning and policies
- Policy instruments /governance as critical enablers or barriers to adoption
- Shift from ,government' to ,governance'
- Lack of specific and proven local policy instrument examples ... until now!



Urban Governance Atlas

- Interactive online database of ~250 policy instruments currently in Beta format
- Co-created with local/regional governments, scientific community, financial experts, ...
- In English and Spanish... with more to come!
- Aims to:
 - Inspire global action through good practice instruments with detailed lessons learned
 - Represent diverse contexts (institutional/ geographic) – bottom up & top down
 - Foster ecologically coherent, inclusive planning for urban ecosystem restoration and green space planning

The Mesa para la Conservación del Sur del Valle de Aburrá is a cooperation instrument based on an inter-institutional articulation effort...




National Park City campaign -London

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Types of policy instruments, by region




In EU the two more represented types of instruments are:


- legislative ($\sim 40\%$)
- Agreement based (~30%)


In CELAC the legislative instruments are the most common type: (~60%)

Policy instruments, by subcategory




Some characteristics of the policy instruments...





A few first observations...

NBS are often not labelled as such in CELAC region, but are frequently used to support climate change adaptation, water management and disaster risk reduction policies





Largely untapped potential to utilise multiple policy instruments to complement each other, especially knowledge/communication/innovation and cooperative/agreement-based instruments



Collaborative governance approaches at the *regional scale* are common in the CELAC context, but are more common at the *local scale* in the EU



Revenues from environmental damage charges and municipal taxes are often used to finance NBS implementation – but payments/subsidies and incentives are more common than disincentives



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
