How do YOU want to learn about science communication?


mountain.WOCUR offers four kinds of knowledge

I get many of my ideas by looking at other people's work results. A collection of **best practice examples** is very helpful.


When facing a new problem, I like to ask others about their **experiences** first. I can learn more from their solutions and conclusions than from books.
