How do YOU want to learn about science communication?

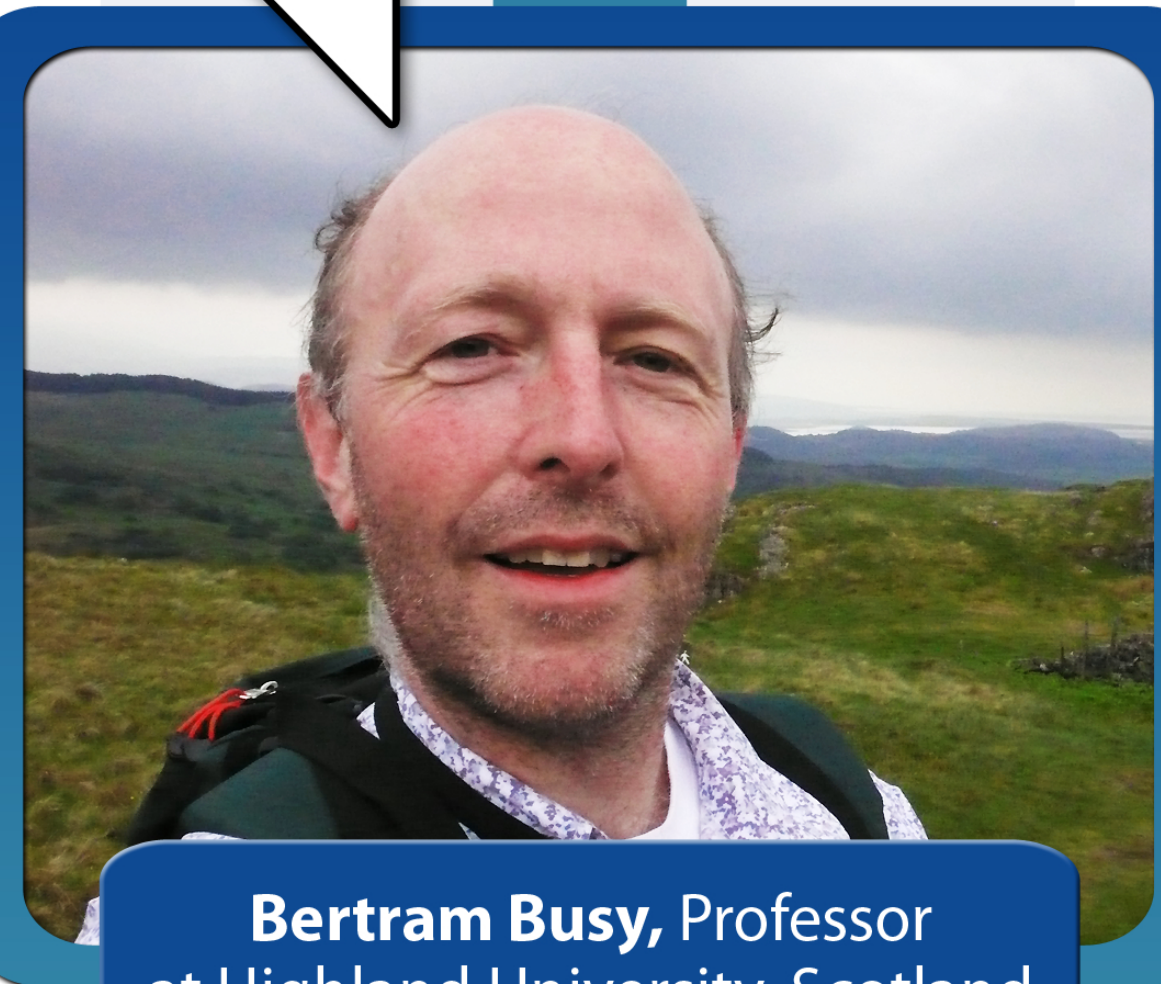
mountain.WOCUR offers four kinds of knowledge

When facing a new problem, I like to ask others about their **experiences** first. I can learn more from their solutions and conclusions than from books.

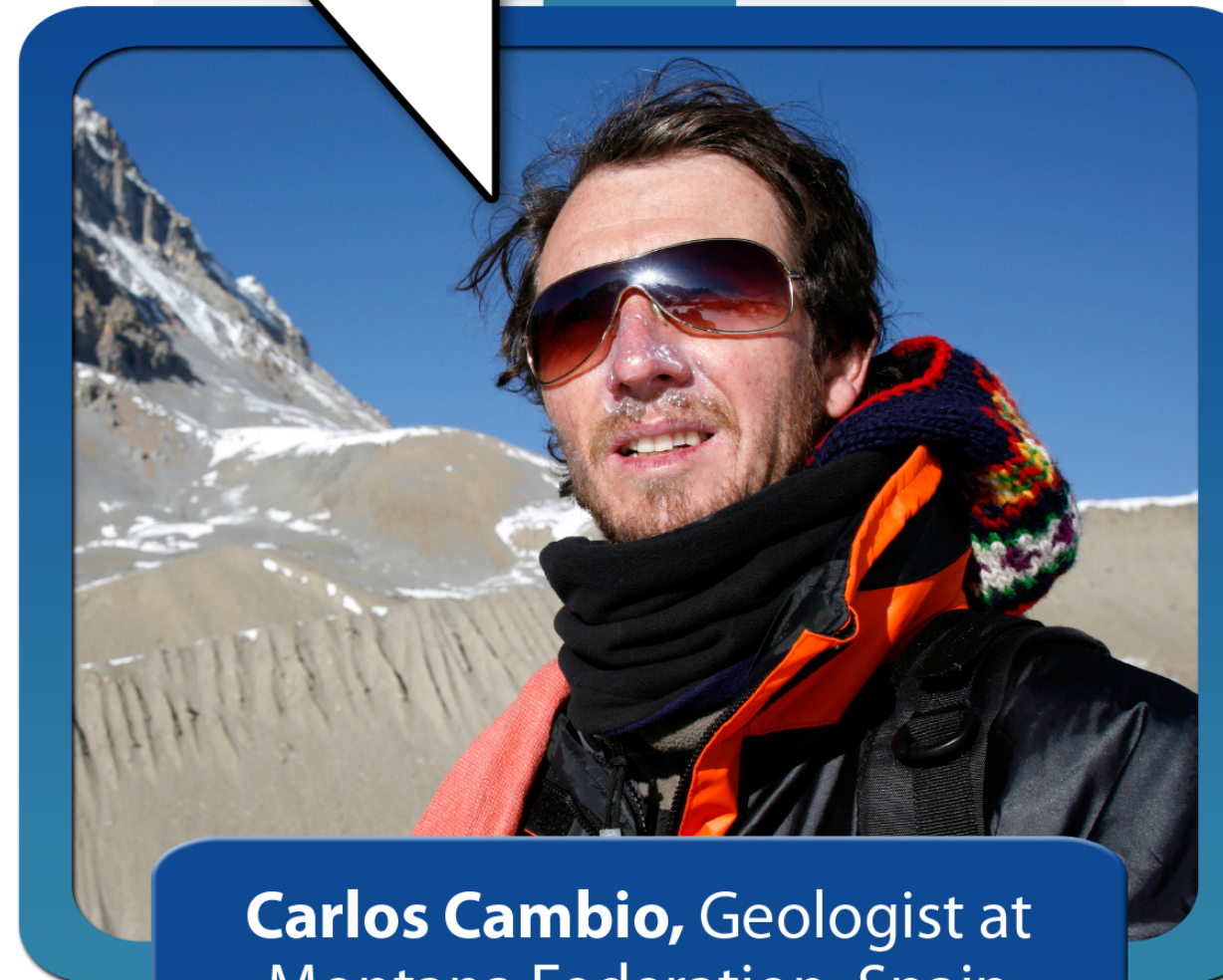
I want to increase my methodological knowledge base on effective science communication. An **encyclopedia** on specific tools, practices and principles is important to me.
