Mission Soil Manifesto: a growing community of Soil Friends and Signatories

The **Mission 'A Soil Deal for Europe'** (**Mission Soil**) provides funding for research and innovation, is creating a network of living labs and lighthouses to develop real-world solutions, supports a harmonised framework for soil monitoring, and promotes widespread awareness of the paramount significance of soils.

The **Mission Soil Manifesto** is a call to action from the Mission Soil, aimed at uniting regional and local policymakers, citizens, and stakeholders, such as land managers, farmers, foresters, educators, companies, and researchers, in a voluntary commitment to prioritize and actively work towards improving soil health. Signatories, without the burden of legal obligations, commit to raising awareness, fostering innovation, and taking tangible steps to protect and restore soil.

MISSION SOIL MANIFESTO OBJECTIVES

- Fostering awareness and action: The Manifesto seeks to raise awareness about the need to protect soil health and encourages signatories to take action to restore and improve soil health, fostering local knowledge, innovation, and investment.
- Community building: The Mission Soil Manifesto strives to connect regional and local policymakers, stakeholders, and citizens to form a vibrant community focused on soil health.



A growing number of individuals and representatives of legal entities, including municipalities, regions, private and public companies, organisations, education and research institutions, and associations, are showing their commitment by signing the Manifesto. These individuals are referred to as "Friends of the Mission," while the legal entities are recognized as "Signatories." (Statistics as of November 11, 2023).

- **Knowledge sharing:** signatories, will have the opportunity to exchange knowledge and collaborate on activities related to soil health.
- Recognition and commitment: organisations and individuals signing the Manifesto demonstrate their commitment to soil health protection and restoration, contributing to a more sustainable future and being recognised for their dedication.
- Momentum building: by becoming advocates for soil health, signatories
 can contribute to building momentum and raising awareness about the
 importance of soil, ensuring that soil health is on top of the agenda in many
 sectors.
- Participation in events: selected Signatories (legal entities) will be celebrated at events like the European Mission Soil Week, providing them with opportunities to showcase their efforts, exchange best practices, and collaborate with other stakeholders.
- One-stop information hub: A dedicated Mission Soil Platform website was created to serve as a central source of information and action, facilitating further engagement and collaboration. Signatories have access to the latest research results, knowledge-sharing activities, and events for exchanging best practices related to soil health.
